Target

The Industry Placement Program (IPP) is an initiative of Monash University Gippsland. It was developed to address the emerging skill requirements of regional organisations, whilst providing invaluable, paid work experience and academic credit to select students undertaking their chosen field of study.

Selection Criteria

Program Features

- Formal (paid) study and work placement, including academic credit
- Work experience (3 weeks during university holidays at start of 3rd year, and 22 weeks during semester at end of 3rd year)
- Pre-selection for full-time employment
- Optional inclusion in the McMillans Development Program

Retention

- Criteria as per the Monash IPP
 - Must maintain a Pass (50%) results average.Maximum 1 N Grade (Failure to pass, with results less than 50%) subject per annum.
